Erev Shabbat

because a BIBLICAL DAY STARTS AT SUNSET:
*Gen 1:5 And Elohim called the light 'day'
and the darkness He called 'night.' And
there came to be evening and there came
to be morning, one day*

Preparations



When the Sixth Day starts:

We have an excitement and joy, because we look forward to a day of rest. The morning of the day, we already prepare our hearts to meet with our Messiah



Shabbat is the Seventh day and a day of rest according to Genesis and Exodus 16 , EXODUS 20, and Deutr. 28.

Exo_16:23 And he said to them, "This is what יהוה has said, 'Tomorrow is a rest, a Sabbath set-apart to יהוה. That which you bake, bake; and that which you cook, cook. And lay up for yourselves all that is left over, to keep it until morning.' "

Or Messiah and King Y'Shua (Jesus Christ) Luke 6:6 as well as Shaul (Paul) celebrate the Seventh day.

Acts 16:13

We follow in Y'Shua's footsteps and as HE is our Branch and example, and HE was a Jewish Rabbi WHO taught in their synagogues, we use some of the symbolism our Hebrew brother from Israel follow, to celebrate our day. Y'Shua renewed Abba Father's COVENANT when HE presented the Bread and the wine to HIS disciples.

We make all the food we need for the evening as well as the next day, and we prepare everything, we go through a Mikvah in time so that we are ready BEFORE THE SUN SETS ON THE EVENING OF THE SIXTH DAY! If we have Guests for Erev Shabbat, we wash their hands with flowing water, as a sign of servanthood, hospitality & humility. (Jug and a dish...)-LIVING WATER...John4:10

The Welcoming

*Psalms 81:3 Blow a shophar in
the New moon, in the covering for
the day of our festival.*



*Psalms 150:3 Praise
Him with the blowing
of a shophar; Praise
Him with the harp*

Before the Shabbat meal starts,
we blow the Shophar(Shōfar), in
welcoming the Shabbat and Praise
Elohim our Father and honour HIM
for giving us another day of rest!

*When our Messiah Y'Shua
will come on the clouds HE
will also announce HIS
coming with the sound of
the shōfar!*

The Candles

*Joh.8:12 The

Y'Shua spoke

Directions

Our Brothers Judah (the Jews) in Israel,
light the candles before sunset on Erev
Shabbat, because they follow the mitzvah
(Instruction) and a reminder of not
kindeling a fire on Shabbat.
We follow this mitzvah for the same reason
but MORE:
Because we remember that our Messiah
Y'Shua is the **Light of the world** & HE
commanded us also to be Light in a dark
world.

There is also no prescriptions what kind of wine or juice to use. Let's call it the FRUIT OF THE VINE:

Messianic prayer over the FRUIT OF THE VINE:

ברוך אתה יהוה אלהינו מלך העולם,

*Blessed are You, YHWH ELOHIM, KING OF THE

our SALVATION.*

The Bread/ Challah or Unleavened Bread



Directions

Luke

22:19,20 And taking bread, giving thanks, He broke it and gave it to them, saying, "This is My body which is given for you, do this in remembrance of Me." Likewise the cup also, after supper, saying, "This cup is the renewed covenant in My blood which is shed for you.

There is no law or instructions about which bread, except for Pesag and the 7 days Feast of Unleavened Bread. The Hebrew people like to do the knotted bread (Challah) which represent the folded arms for not working on Shabbat. Some people make their own unleavened bread to use...Use Any bread...

Prayer over the bread:

ברוך אתה יהוה אלהינו מלך העולם.
המוציא את לחם החיים מן השמים.

ba-rukH at-tah Adonai E-lo-**hei**-nu **me**-lekh ha-o-lam,
ha-mo-tzi et **le**-chem ha-cha-yim min ha-sha-**ma**-yim.

*Blessed are You YHWH ELOHIM, CREATOR
OF THE UNIVERSE, WHO brings forth the
LIVING BREAD from heaven and our
Messiah Y'Shua WHO gave HIMSELF for us
on the stake.*

The Blessings



On Shabbat we bless one another. The Father of the house bless his wife or the mother, and he places his hands on the heads of each child and bless them. If our Family and/or children are far from us, we bless them with prayers and messages. A group of friends together bless one another with a BLESSING from SCRIPTURE.

Aronic Blessing:

Numbers 6:24 "יהוה bless you and guard you; :25 יהוה make His face shine upon you, and show favour to you; :26 יהוה lift up His face upon you, and give you peace."
